

So you want to track a truck, huh? Did you know moving trucks live in busy neighborhoods? Or that ice-cream


trucks migrate south for the winter? Do you know the Universal Truck Signal? (Just make a fist and pull down twice.) This is just the beginning of

Truck tracking can be difficult, even for experts like Mike. Help Mike navigate this maze to find his dump truck.









Do you know what kind of truck lurks in abandoned parking lots? Connect the dots to find out and write the answer below.


